## ***TRIP ITINERARY***

### **Tuesday September 28th, 2010**

Bus will leave New Windsor Town Hall Complex from in front of the Marasco Center at 8:00am aboard a deluxe tour bus for a delightful three day adventure to Rhode Island, the “Ocean State.” “Little Rhody” is the smallest of our 50 states and during this 3-Day Adventure we will see it all. By mid-day we’ll be in Providence for **sight-seeing** and a tour of the **Rhode Island School of Design** and the renowned **Johnson and Wales Culinary College and Museum**. Our hotel for two nights will be **The Providence Biltmore**, one of the Historic Hotels of America ideally located in the center of the city. Tonight enjoy **DINNER** in Providence’s **Little Italy**. Many Italian immigrants settled in Rhode Island, so the Italian heritage runs deep, and the authentic Italian cooking is outstanding.

### **Wednesday September 29th, 2010**

This morning we’ll follow the shores of Narragansett Bay to **Newport**. One of the most famous resort towns in the Northeast, Newport has a long seafaring heritage. It’s a Navy town and also the Summer vacation retreat of the rich and famous. Start with a scenic tour through the town and past Fort Adams where the Newport Jazz Festival is held. Then continue along Newport’s **10 mile Ocean Drive** and past many famous mansions. Our guide will tell you all about Newport’s “Gilded Age”. Next comes a **LUNCHEON CRUISE** on Newport Harbor and Narragansett Bay. In the afternoon we’ll tour the famous oceanfront mansion called “**The Breakers**” where the Vanderbilt’s lived and visit the **International Lawn Tennis Hall of Fame** with groomed grass courts and a **Tennis Museum in the historic Newport Casino**. Enjoy some free time for shopping at Brick Market Place, historic Rose Wharf and America’s Cup Avenue. Pause for dinner in Newport (on own) before we return to Providence.

### **Thursday September 30th, 2010**

This morning we’ll head into Rhode Island’s **Blackstone Valley to Slater Mill**, where America’s Industrial Revolution began. Tour the historic Mill as well as the award winning **Museum of Work and Culture**, a tribute to entire generations of immigrants who worked in the textile mills. We’ll take a **riverboat cruise** along the Blackstone River and enjoy **LUNCH** at Christopher’s of Woonsocket.
